



**ITS ALL SYSTEMS GO AT THE MARIKANA COMMISSION AS THE SITTINGS RESUME
TODAY, 25th FEBRUARY 2013**

Following last week's delays due to water and electricity problems, the Commission will resume this morning, Monday, 25th February at 10:00 at the Rustenburg Civic Centre.

The City's Executive Mayor, Cllr Mpho Khunou, Municipal Manager, Dr Kiddo Mako, and the rest of the management team, carried a final inspection early hours of this morning and confirmed that water and electricity services have been fully restored.

"My team and I understand the importance of having this Commission here in Rustenburg. In view of last week's water and electricity problems which impacted negatively on the Commission's work, we decided to work over the weekend to have all these problems resolved. In addition, we have made a commitment to the Commission's Secretariat to provide both water and electricity back up to avoid unplanned service interruptions," remarks Municipal Manager, Dr Kiddo Mako.

Mr Sipheth Phatsha, a witness for the participants in the strike is expected to conclude with his testimony today. Advocate Mpofu, will then call his last witness Mr Mzoxolo Magidiwana.
