MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY CONTINUES

North West Deputy Provincial Commissioner Major General Ganasen Naidoo, from the South African Police Service (SAPS), has continued giving testimony at the Marikana Commission during the week, under cross-examination from various legal representatives.

The witness was this week cross-examined by Advocate Michelle Le Roux, on behalf of the South African Human Rights Commission (SAHRC), Advocate Dumisa Ntsebeza SC, on behalf of the families of the deceased, and Advocate Dali Mpofu on behalf of the injured and arrested strikers, among others. Adv. Mpofu will continue his cross-examination on Monday 17 March, when the Commission resumes.

The Commission will only sit on Monday the 17th and Tuesday 18 March 2014. It will therefore not hold hearings on Wednesday 19 March, Thursday 20 March and Friday 21 March 2014.

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 17 March 2014 at 09:00 in Centurion.
