**MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY CONTINUES**

The Marikana Commission this week heard testimony from Captain Wayne Peter Kidd, Colonel Classen and Constable Edward Sebatjane all from the South African Police Service (SAPS). The witnesses were cross-examined by various legal parties at the Commission.

Colonel Classen is expected to be re-called as the next witness to continue testifying and to be re-examined by the SAPS legal team when the Commission resumes on Monday 2 June. Mr Michael Gomes Da Costa, from Lonmin, will then be called as the next witness.

Next week the Commission will not have hearings on Wednesday 4 June 2014, however there will be hearings on Monday 2 June, Tuesday 3 June, Thursday 5 June and Friday 6 June 2014.

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 2 June 2014 at 09:00 in Centurion.
