MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY TO CONTINUE ON 14 JULY 2014

Mr X continued being led on his evidence-in-chief by Advocate Frank Mathibedi SC, for the SAPS on Monday 30 June and Tuesday 01 July 2014. Adv. Geoff Budlender SC, on behalf of the evidence leaders started cross-examining Mr X on Tuesday and continued until Thursday 3 July 2014.

The Commission had to adjourn on Thursday because Mr X asked to be allowed time to mourn the death of a family member.

The Marikana Commission will resume on Monday 14 July 2014. Former Police Minister Nathi Mthethwa is expected to start giving evidence when the Commission resumes.

Members of the media are hereby reminded to abide by the Chairperson of the Commission, Judge Farlam's ruling on the coverage of Mr X's testimony at the Commission. Judge Farlam made the following rulings, among others:

- **That neither the name nor any other information that may reveal the identity of Mr X shall be disclosed further by any party other than the SAPS save for the purpose of obtaining instructions.**
- **That members of the media may not publish the name of Mr X or any other information which may reveal his identity.**

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 14 July 2014 at 09:00 in Centurion.
