MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY CONTINUES

This week the Marikana Commission heard testimony from Mr Michael Da Costa who was the manager of Lonmin's Karee mine in 2012, Mr X and three of Lonmin's security officials, Mr Dewald Louw, Mr Mogomotsi Joseph Masibi and Mr Akanyang Julius Motlogelwa. Mr X could not finish his testimony on Tuesday due to ill health. He will be called back to the Commission to continue giving evidence at a later stage.

Mr Motlogelwa will continue testifying when the Commission resumes next week. The next witness to be called is Mr Dirk Botes, who is a Lonmin security official.

The Marikana Commission will resume on Monday 28 July 2014 and will have hearings from Monday 28 July until Friday 01 August 2014.

Deputy President Cyril Ramaphosa will not be giving evidence at the Commission during the next week, as had been stated earlier. He is expected to testify sometime in mid-August 2014. The exact date will be announced at a later stage.

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 28 July 2014 at 09:00 in Centurion.
