MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY CONTINUES

The Marikana Commission heard testimony from Deputy President Mr Cyril Ramaphosa on Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 August 2014. Yesterday the Commission had a presentation of the deceased in Marikana. Captain Veerasamy Govender, the Visible Policing Commander in Marikana, gave testimony on the work he did during the Marikana strike.

Next week, the Marikana Commission will only have hearings on Monday 18th and Tuesday 19 August 2014. The Commission will **not** sit on Wednesday 20, Thursday 21 and Friday 22 August 2014.

Mr Shadrack Zandisile Mtshamba, who is employed by Lonmin as a Rock Drill Operator (RDO) will start giving evidence at the Commission on Monday. His testimony will be followed by that of Mr Xolani Nzuza who is also a Lonmin employee.

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 18 August 2014 at 09:30 in Centurion.
