### **MARIKANA COMMISSION OF INQUIRY CONTINUES**

This week the Marikana Commission heard testimony from Mr Xolani Nzuza, a former Lonmin employee, former Minister of Mineral Resources Ms Susan Shabangu and the Manager of Mining Security at Lonmin's Western Platinum Division Mr Henry Blou.

The Commission will sit on Monday 1 September, Tuesday 2, Wednesday 3, Thursday 4 and Friday 5 September 2014.

Mr Henry Blou will continue giving evidence when the Commission resumes on Monday 1 September 2014. His testimony will be followed by that of Mr Graeme Sinclair, Lonmin group Mining Emergency and Security Manager. On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday the Commission will hear testimony from Policing experts Mr Gary White, Mr Cess De Rover and Mr Eddie Hendrickx.

Mr Barnard Mokoena, one of Lonmin's senior Managers, is expected to start his testimony at the Commission on Friday 5 September 2014.

The Marikana Commission of Inquiry will reconvene on Monday 1 September 2014 at 09:00 in Centurion.
