

Ntsebeza takes over

POLITICAL activist Advocate Dumisa Ntsebeza is expected to take over from Advocate Dali Mpofu at the Marikana Commission of Inquiry today.

Ntsebeza will represent families of the victims and will resume cross-examining Police Commissioner Riah Phiyega, because Mpofu was injured in a robbery in East London last week.

Mpofu's doctors have advised him to stay at home until he has fully recovered.

His instructing attorney, Mapula Keetse, said: "He will be back when he is fit enough to continue."

Commission spokesman Tshepo Mahlangu said: "We are likely to have Ntsebeza because he has indicated that he wanted to cross-examine Phiyega."

Mahlangu said the commission did not see a link between its work and the attack on Mpo-fu. Mpo-fu has also repeatedly said he does not think the attack was linked to his work at the commission.

He appears to have been a victim of a mugging at the beach between Eastern Beach and Nahoon Reef in East London.
